Author Workshop - Write Like a Scholar, Think Like a Reviewer

Fostering Research Excellence through Scholarly Writing

The Faculty of Computer Science and Information Technology (FCSIT), Universiti Malaya, in collaboration with Bon View Publishing, successfully organised the *Author Workshop – “Write Like a Scholar, Think Like a Reviewer”* on 07 July 2025. The programme attracted a total of 122 participants, combining both physical attendance and online attendees via Zoom, comprising postgraduate students, early-career researchers, and academic staff.

This initiative reflects the faculty’s commitment to nurturing research capabilities and fostering excellence in academic publishing across the university community.

Objectives of the Workshop

The workshop aimed to:

- Enhance academic writing skills aligned with international publishing standards
- Guide participants in identifying legitimate indexed journals
- Equip scholars with strategies for crafting impactful abstracts and responding to peer reviews
- Encourage responsible research publication practices and engagement as Guest Editors

Key Highlights

The event was conducted in two main sessions:

Session 1: Get Published in Indexed Journals

This session covered practical steps in choosing suitable journals, understanding journal indexing, avoiding predatory publications, and aligning manuscript scopes with the intended audience.

Session 2: Making Your Abstract Stand Out

Participants learned the structure and techniques for writing concise, compelling abstracts based on the APA style. Emphasis was placed on writing abstracts that clearly reflect the purpose, method, findings, and significance of the research.

- One-on-one expert feedback on their abstracts
- Publication pathway discussions with Bon View Publishing representatives
- Discount vouchers for Article Processing Charges (APC)

- E-certificates of participation for both on-site and virtual attendees
